



①Lake Banryuko

A lake in the shape of a coiled up dragon. There is a leisurely foot path which circles the lake.



⑤Ikoji Temple

There is a zen garden designed by Sesshu at this temple. The gate of this temple was originally the main gate of Nanao Castle in Masuda.



②Grand Toit

Prefectural museum compound with several display halls and theatres, which features live kagura performances each Sunday evening..



⑥Manpukuji

This zen garden was designed by Sesshu. The main building and the garden are national important cultural properties.



③Takatsu Kakinomoto Shrine

This shrine was moved from the place Kakinomoto Hitomaro's death in Matsuda city. The main building is a prefectural cultural property



⑦Amano Iwakatsu Shrine

This shrine was worshipped by the Masuda clan in the Middle Ages. The main building is designated a national important cultural property.



④Toda Kakinomoto Shrine

This shrine was constructed at the birth place of Kakinomoto Hitomaro.



⑧Sesshu Memorial Museum

The famous portrait of "Masuda Kanetaka" painted by Sesshu which is a national important cultural property is regularly on display. It has many collections related to Sesshu.
