



①Lake Banryuko

(3) Takatsu Kakinomoto Shrine

This zen garden was designed by Sesshu. The main building and the garden are national important cultural properties.



(7) Amano Iwakatsu Shrine

This shrine was worshiped by the Masuda clan in the Middle Ages. The main building is designated a national important cultural property.
