



⑨History and Folk Museum

This building was the county hall in the Taisho period (1912-1825). It has a collection of everyday artifacts dating from the feudal age to the present donated by the people of Masuda.



⑮Minoji Yashiki

Wealthy Farmer's house constructed in the Edo Period (1603-1868). Pass through the dignity gate and you will find the large main building.



⑲Hata Memorial Museum

The museum of bacteriologist Dr. Sahachirou Hata. Dr. Hata (1873-1938) was born in the house next to the museum.

⑩⑪⑫Onsens(hotspring)

Araiso Onsen (Seaside) ⑩, Tada Onsen (if you stay over a traditional meal of wild plants is available) ⑪, Otani Onsen (Mountain) ⑫



⑰Hikimi-kyo Onsen

Enjoy a beautiful view of the seasonable flowers and nature from the public bath. Rock bath and open-air bath.



⑳Sekishu Washi Museum

This house was originally a paper mill. The Hirokane family used to make Sekishu Washi (traditional Japanese paper) for the Hamada clan at this site.

⑬Miyake Odoi Ato

Site of the Masuda Family Mansion (1368-1600). 190m×110m



⑰Hikimi-kyo Rest Park

This is at the entrance of Ura-Hikimikyo. There are cabins, campsites, and tennis courts available.



㉑Mito Onsen

Hot spring. The water is very therapeutic for your skin. Effective for pain and poor blood circulation.

⑭Ruins of Nanao Castle

Mountain castle built after the Battle of Genji & Heike. Used for 400 years until the beginning of the Edo period.



⑳Hikimi Wood Park

A museum containing wooden art pieces such as puzzles, bowls etc. and a natural park with a refreshing scent of the woods.



㉒San-eito Mito

A shop & restaurant at the entrance of Mito Onsen. You can buy special products of the Mito area here.
